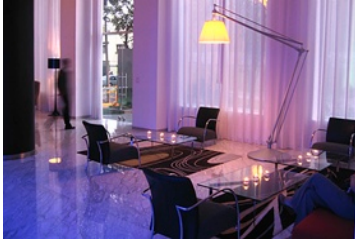

morning: drive to fish market in Paita and meet the women of La Isllilla

continue on to La Isllilla: discuss with the women how they would run their water delivery business

afternoon: visit businesses started from microloans; sail out in a fishing boat and learn more about the fishing industry

evening: dinner and recap of the day

wednesday feb 3 piura

morning: signing of letter of intent for the loan with CEPESER

afternoon: fly to Cusco

evening: check in to bungalows at Niños del Arco Iris in the Sacred Valley
dinner and recap of the day

thursday feb 4 machu picchu

morning: take the train to Machu Picchu, the famous Inca ruins

afternoon: travel to Cusco by train

friday feb 5 cusco

all day: tour the city

evening: closing dinner

saturday feb 6 cusco and return home

morning: free time; optional visit to Inca market for souvenirs

afternoon: fly to Lima

evening: depart on overnight flight
